Wellness Policy

Your child should not be in the nursery or child care if any of the following conditions exist:

Fever: Temperature should be below 100 degrees for at least 24 hours without medication. **Runny nose with green discharge or a persistent cough:** Young children do not cover their mouths consistently or blow their noise effectively which can easily transmit cold germs to other children or staff.

Diarrhea: Free of loose stools for at least 8 hours, preferably 24 hours, **AND** be able to eat and drink normally.

Vomiting: No vomiting for 24 hours AND be able to eat and drink normally.

Sore throat, unexplained rash, skin infection, or head lice.

Any infection that has not been treated with antibiotics such as strep throat or pink eye.

Our goal is to keep all children, staff, and volunteers healthy. If your child is in the nursery or childcare and is exhibiting these symptoms, we will ask a parent to come and remove the child from the room.
